Burgundy (Santenay)

Lucien Muzard's sons, Hervé and Claude now run the domaine. They are the ninth generation of a family that can trace its lineage in Santenay back to 1666. While they respect traditional wine-making practices, they also keep an open mind to modern changes in viniculture. In the vineyards they have greatly reduced grape yields to intensify flavour. In the cellar they have eliminated fining and only filter when strictly necessary. This is a source of spotlessly pure great value Burgundy.

2008 Corton Charlemagne Grand cru

"(from a 50/50 blend of Pernand and Aloxe fruit). A gently wooded, fresh and perfumed nose of green apple and acacia blossom gives way to rich, delicious and seductively textured medium-bodied flavors that possess excellent intensity and fine delineation on the citrusy and persistent finish where a mild toastiness resurfaces. 2008 Santenay BLANC 'Champs Claude'

"A discreet but noticeable hint of wood frames pure and pretty citrus suffused floral aromas that serve as an elegant introduction to the delicious and attractively plump middle weight flavors that manage to pull off the tricky balance of a round mid-palate but precise finish that offers both good length as well as a touch of minerality on the agreeably dry and crisp finale. 2007 Bourgogne Rouge

2006 Santenay Rouge 1er Cru 'Maladières'
