Chablis

Domaine Denis Pommier is a small estate based in the village of Poinchy just west of Chablis. In 1990 Denis Pommier inherited from his grandfather, 2.5 hectares of established vineyards in Chablis AC, and 1er cru Beauroy and Fourchaume. Denis also acquired small parcels of land from his aunt in Petit Chablis and Chablis AC and has added an excellent holding of old vines 1er cru Cote de Lechet. The domaine now covers 13 hectares where Denis, and his wife Isabelle, make wonderfully pure Chablis as well as a tiny amount of Pinot Noir Bourgogne rouge from very low yielding vines more than 50 years old. His wines right across the range show great purity and offer remarkable value.

**2008 Bourgogne rouge - Stelvin closure** From a 55 y.o. vineyard located 10kms west of Chablis, matured in barrique (none new).

**2007 Petit Chablis** - Matured in 100% Stainless steel. "A classic Chablis nose of mineral reduction and green fruit and... the crisp and mineral driven flavours are intense and crisp and acidity provides real lift to the dry finish. This is really a lovely effort for this level of Chablis." **87/2010+ Burghound**

**2007 Chablis AC** - Matured in 100% Stainless steel. "A perfumed green fruit, salt water and iodine suffused nose compliments the richer and bigger flavours that are at once round yet detailed while culminating in a sappy finish with so much Chablis character." **88/2010+ Burghound.com Oct 2009**

**2007 Chablis vieilles vignes** - From 40 y.o. vines, matured 50% in tank and 50% in barrique (none new). Notably intense and complex

**2007 Chablis 1er Cru Beauroy** - From 25 + 55 yo vines, matured 2/3rd's in tank and 1/3rd in barrel (none new). "This is notably more elegant than it usually is and really quite pretty. Worth a look." **90/2012+ Burghound.com October 2009**

**2007 Chablis 1er Cru Cote de Lechet** - 60 yo vines, matured part tank and part barrel. "As it always is, this offers a notable step up in elegance with its relatively high-toned nose of lemon zest and wet stone that is trimmed in an almost invisible touch of wood that does not continue onto the rich round and utterly delicious medium-bodied flavors that possess a discernable salinity and really lovely finishing intensity where the hallmark citrus character re-surfaces." **90/2011+ Burghound Oct 2009**

**2007 Chablis 1er Cru Fourchaume** - "A wonderfully and expressive and nuanced nose combines notes of mineral reduction, iodine, tidal pool and green fruit that compliment perfectly the round rich and minerally flavors that possess a fine sense of focus on the driving finish that displays a pungent Chablis character." **91/2012+ Burghound Oct 2009**
